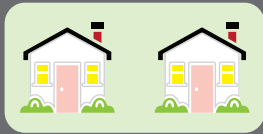
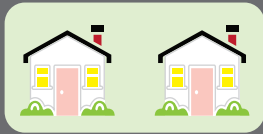
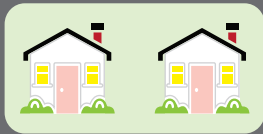


A Friendly Neighborhood

Miss Derringer: There is a purple house due north of my house, but I can't see it from my house because there is a brown house in the way.

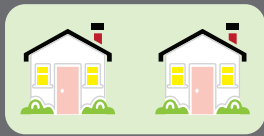
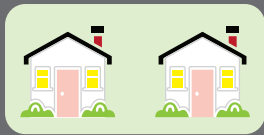
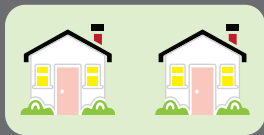
Mrs. Basuri: I can walk to Mrs. Eriksen's house without crossing any streets.
